- Pharmacology of buprenorphine
- Medical and regulatory guidelines for prescribing buprenorphine.

The two parts of this course comprise 8 hours of training required to obtain a waiver to prescribe buprenorphine under the DATA2000 Act. Regulations require physicians to complete 8 hours of approved training and NPs and PAs 24 hours in order to be eligible for the waiver.
